Administrator

Trisha Roach reported on the high school enrollment numbers. The CIH (College in the High School) program has confirmed they will have a PE college credit available through Wenatchee Valley College. Mrs. Roach spoke about the school wide community service project. Students were blown away at the gratitude shown for their efforts. Students picked up garbage, cleaned gardens, yardwork, washed firetrucks, etc. A challenge they are dealing with is getting Freshmen off of the F-list. The HS is in the process of figuring out the next steps forward with the large number of students failing and how this will affect Summer School and schedules next year. SBAC testing started this week and Prom is this upcoming weekend. The HS is also preparing for all things Seniors and graduation.

Kelwy El-Haj started by thanking MS student Grayson for coming to speak at the last two board meetings. The MS is beginning their 8th grade promotion planning. The Japanese exchange teacher has started teaching throughout the MS. She is giving Japanese language lessons and lessons on Japanese culture. She has also done some lessons in the elementary school. Her daughter is attending 6th grade and is enjoying the experience. The MS science team has applied for a grant to attend a training on new science curriculum. Mrs. El-Haj reports that MS have also started preparing for summer school. The MS Counselor is continuing her anti bullying teaching, she has done 7th is currently teaching 6th and will move onto 8th grade. The migrant program has 23 students that will attend the college sponsored 'dare to dream academy' this summer. The final migrant meeting is May 24th.

Lilly Martin discussed the ES enrollment numbers. There ES had a professional development today from the ESD and it is a two part training series. There is a new shared basketball court on the K-1 playground. It will be shared between the high school and elementary at different times. The ES is currently SBAC testing.
